What happens next?

You will be transferred near the end of Year 11, and you will be seen at RHH within 6 months of your last appointment at Sheffield Children's Hospital. If you need new batteries or help with your hearing aid before your appointment at RHH then contact the Sheffield Children's Hospital workshop as before on 0114 2717462

After my first appointment at RHH, what do I do if I need a new mould, new batteries or my hearing aid breaks?

Make an appointment with an audiologist **telephoning 0114 226 1314 or text message 07917721604**

Batteries are available from Hearing Services reception desk any day **Monday to Friday between 9.00am and 4.45pm**. No appointment is necessary. **It is important to bring your brown hearing aid record book with you.** We will tell you about other ways of getting batteries when you come to clinic

Will I be offered a loan aid if mine is broken?

Yes

Will there be a signing interpreter available if I need one?

Yes. Please let the department know well in advance.

Will the department know about my hearing loss and hearing aids when I arrive?

Yes. Your file is photocopied and sent from the Children's Hospital.

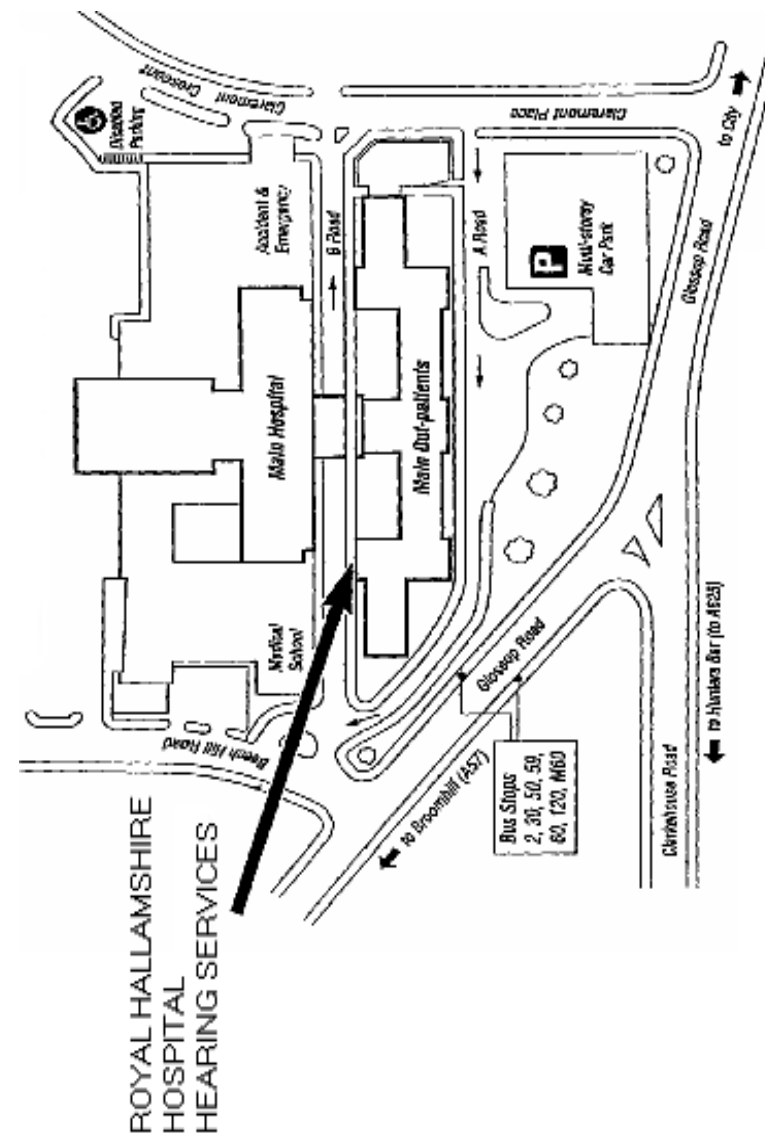
